- Acupuncture
- Naturopathy
- Osteopathy.



Maryknoll Therapeutic Community

- Up to 77 residents
- Nine-month program

Integration Housing and Aftercare is available for residents leaving the Therapeutic Communities.

Youth Residential Withdrawal

At our Windana Youth Community House in Dandenong, young people stay for supported withdrawal in a homelike environment.

Adult Residential Withdrawal

Our holistic seven to ten-day program in St Kilda.
